The German government signs basic agreements worth up to 40 million euros to modernise its administration.

Munich, the 2nd of February 2007

ESG Elektroniksystem- und Logistik-GmbH will be advising various German government ministries, government authorities and recipients of grants (such as foundations) on project management and project controlling until 2010. The total plan is divided into three phases, and covers a total volume of 40 million euros.
